Join us for the first of a series of hands-on workshops which will explore the park's terrain, identify native and invasive plants, and encourage stewardship of New London's natural resources. Led by environmental educator Suzanne Thompson, the sessions will be timed with nature cycles throughout the spring, summer, fall, and winter seasons.

The first session will include exploration of the Riverside Park site, with a focus on examining the plants that grow there and the creatures that depend on them for food and shelter.
